NYCSeed

The NYC Seed fund is designed to support seed-stage high potential technology firms in New York City with up to \$200,000 to commercialize innovative new products. The NYC Seed partnership was created by the New York City Investment Fund, NYSTAR, Polytechnic University and ITAC in order to offer a unique set of collaborative tools, including business financing and mentoring to creative technology startups.

SBIR Coaching (help in obtaining government grants)

ITAC is one of three organizations in New York State funded to help companies compete aggressively for federal Small Business Innovation Research (SBIR) research dollars. ITAC coaches qualified companies in SBIR/STTR partnerships, strategy, proposal creation, application budget structure, and Phase 1 project management to encourage further awards.

Kauffman FastTrac Program (business boot-camp)

ITAC has been the Marion Ewing Kauffman Foundation's certified provider of FastTrac entrepreneurship training in NYC for 8 years. Graduates of ITAC's 12-week program, offered twice a year, have shown tremendous business impact. Spaces are awarded competitively to leaders in high-potential firms.

JumpStart (assistance with R&D of new materials)

The JumpStart program of the Cornell Center for Materials Research (CCMR) helps small New York businesses to develop ongoing collaborations with university research centers. JumpStart companies can be awarded a one-semester university-industry project and up to \$5,000 in matching state funds.
